Mark 11:24

"Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask **when** you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."

This is a powerful verse for us in this season of prayer. When do we believe that we receive? According to the words of Jesus in this verse, it is **when** we pray. **When** we pray we believe that we receive the things we have asked. It isn't once we see them but it is **when** we pray.
