

Declaration Week May 14 – 20, 2007

“So Jesus answered and said to them, Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever *says to this mountain*, Be removed and be cast into the sea, and does not doubt in his heart, but *believes that those things he says will be done*, he will have *whatever he says*. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, *believe that you receive them, and you will have them.*” (Mark 11:22-24)

Quote from Charles Capps, “Words are containers. They carry faith or fear, and they produce after their kind.”

How do I use this booklet? Each day you will find scriptures and proclamations to declare. Declare them over yourself, family, our church, our community, and the surrounding area. Feel free once you have declared the scripture to pray the scripture. Try and take a few minutes on each scripture or proclamation. REMEMBER your words have creative power when released from a believing heart.

Monday May 14, 2007 Proclamations to Overcome Worry and Fear

- 1) *“I am the body of Christ and Satan hath no power over me. For I overcome evil with good.”* (I Corinthians 12:27, Romans 12:21)

Example of how to use when praying for our church and community...

“The Potter’s House is the body of Christ and Satan hath no power over The Potter’s House. The Potter’s House overcomes evil with good.”

“The church of Mt. Pleasant is the body of Christ and Satan hath no power of the church of Mt. Pleasant. The church of Mt. Pleasant overcomes evil with good.”

- 2) *“I am of God and have overcome Him (Satan). For greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world.”* (I John 4:4)
- 3) *“I will fear no evil for thou are with me Lord, your Word and your Spirit they comfort me.”* (Psalm 23:4)
- 4) *“I am far from oppression, and fear does not come nigh me.”* (Isaiah 54:14)

Example:

My family will be far from oppression, and fear does not come near or control my family.

The Potter's House is far from oppression, and fear does not come near or control the people at Potter’s House.”

- 5) *"No weapon formed against me shall prosper, for my righteousness is of the Lord. But whatever I do will prosper for I'm like a tree that's planted by the rivers of water."* (Isaiah 54:17, Psalm 1:3)
- 6) *"No evil will befall me neither shall any plague come nigh my dwelling. For the Lord has given His angels charge over me and they keep me in all my ways, and in my pathway is life and there is no death."* (Psalm 91:10-11, Proverbs 12:28)
- 7) *"I am a doer of the Word of God and am blessed in my deeds. I am happy in those things which I do because I am a doer of the Word of God."* (James 1:22)
- 8) *"I am an overcomer and I overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony, and I love not my life unto death."* (Revelation 12:11)
- 9) *"I am submitted to God and the devil flees from me because I resist him in the name of Jesus."* (James 4:7)
- 10) *"I do follow the Good Shepherd and I know His voice, and the voice of a stranger I will not follow."* (John 10:4-5)
- 11) *"I receive the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of my understanding being enlightened. And I am not conformed to this world but am transformed by the renewing of my mind. My mind is renewed by the Word of God."* (Ephesians 1:17-18, Romans 12:2)

Tuesday May 15, 2007 Proclamations for Healing

- 1) *"Jesus is the Lord of my life. Sickness and disease have no power over me. I am forgiven and free from sin and guilt. I am dead to sin and alive unto righteousness." (Colossians 1:21-22)*
- 2) *"I am free from unforgiveness and strife. I forgive others as Christ has forgiven me, for the love of God is shed abroad in my heart by the Holy Ghost." (Matthew 6:12, Romans 5:5)*
- 3) *"Jesus bore my sins in His body on the tree; therefore I am dead to sin and alive unto God and by His stripes I am healed and made whole." (1 Peter 2:24, Romans 6:11, 2 Corinthians 5:21)*
- 4) *"You have given me abundant life. I receive that life through Your Word and it flows to every organ of my body bringing healing and health." (John 10:10, John 6:33)*
- 5) *"Jesus bore my sickness and carried my pain. Therefore I give no place to sickness or pain. For God sent His Word and healed me." (Psalm 107:20)*
- 6) *"Heavenly Father, I attend to Your Word. I incline my ears to Your sayings. I will not let them depart from my eyes. I keep them in the midst of my heart, for they are life and healing to all my flesh." (Proverbs 4:20-22)*
- 7) *"No evil will befall me, neither shall any plague come near my dwelling. For You have given Your angels charge over me. They keep me in all my ways. In my pathway is life, healing, and health." (Psalm 91:10-11, Proverbs 12:28)*

- 8) *"I am redeemed from the curse. Galatians 3:13 is flowing in my blood stream. It flows to every cell of my body, restoring life and health."* (Mark 11:23, Luke 17:6)
- 9) *"God is on my side. God is in me now; who can be against me? He has given unto me all things that pertain unto life and godliness. Therefore I am a partaker of His divine nature. (2 Corinthians 6:16, John 10:10, 2 Peter 1:3-4, Romans 8:31)*
- 10) *"I am a believer and these signs do follow me. In the name of Jesus I cast out demons, I speak with new tongues, I lay hands on the sick and they do recover."* (Mark 16:17-18)
- 11) *"Jesus gave me the authority to use His name. And that which I bind on earth is bound in heaven. And that which I loose on earth is loosed in heaven. Therefore in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ I bind the principalities, the powers, the rulers of the darkness of this world. I bind and cast down spiritual wickedness in high places and render them harmless and ineffective against me in the name of Jesus."* (Matthew 16:19, John 16:23-24, Ephesians 6:12)

Wednesday May 16, 2007 "Proclamations for Awakening"

- 1) *"Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the Lord will arise over you, And His glory will be seen upon you. **The Gentiles shall come to your light,** And kings to the brightness of your rising."* (Isaiah 60:1-3)
- 2) *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world should be saved through Him."* (John 3:16-17)
- 3) *"The Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."* (Luke 19:10)
- 4) *"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance."* (2 Peter 3:9)
- 5) *"The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them."* (Isaiah 9:2)
- 6) *"Awake to righteousness, and sin not..."* (I Corinthians 15:34a)
- 7) *"Therefore He says: Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light."* (Ephesians 5:14)
- 8) *"the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the Gospel of the glory of Christ." We declare that these blinders will be taken off of the minds and hearts of those in our community and in our families who have not yet received Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 4:4)*
- 9) *"that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened."* (Ephesians 1:17-18a)

- 10) *“pray that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified...”* (2 Thessalonians 3:1)
- 11) *“Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”* (Matthew 6:10)

Thursday May 17, 2007 Proclamations for Finances

1. *“I am filled with the knowledge of God’s will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. His will is my prosperity (Shalom).”* (Colossians 1:19)
2. *“God delights in my prosperity. He gives me power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant upon the earth.”* (Deuteronomy 8:18, 11:12)
3. *“I immediately respond in faith to the guidance of the Holy Spirit within me. I am always in the right place at the right time because my steps are ordered of the Lord.”* (Psalm 37:23)
4. *“God has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness, and I am well able to possess all that God has provided me.”* (Numbers 13:30, 2 Peter 1:3-4)
5. *“God is the unfailing, unlimited source of my supply. My financial income now increases as the blessings of the Lord overtake me.”* (Deuteronomy 28:2)
6. *“I am like a tree planted by rivers of water. I bring forth fruit in my season, my leaf shall not wither, and whatever I do will prosper.* (Psalm 1:3)
7. *“My God makes all grace abound toward me in every favor and earthly blessing, so that I have all sufficiency for all things and abound to every good work.”* (2 Corinthians 9:8)
8. *“The Lord rebukes the devourer for my sake, and no weapon formed against my finances will prosper. All obstacles and hindrances to my financial prosperity are now dissolved.”* (Malachi 3:10-11, Isaiah 54:17)
9. *“My mind is renewed by the Word of God; therefore, I forbid thoughts of failure and defeat to inhabit my mind.”* (Ephesians 4:23)
10. *“I am delivered from the power and authority of darkness. I cast down reasonings and imaginations that exalt themselves against the knowledge of God, and I bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of God’s Word.”* (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)
11. *“There is no lack, for my God supplies all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”* (Philippians 4:19)

Declare the following to debt in your life, family, and brothers and sisters in the body. You may want to take out any notes, mortgages, etc. you may have and lay hands on them as you declare God’s Word:

“In Jesus name and on the authority of His Holy Word, I call these debts PAID IN FULL! Debt, I speak to you in Jesus’ name: Be paid and be gone! Dematerialize and cease to exist! I now declare that all my debts, mortgages, and notes are Paid in Full, Cancelled, or Dissolved!”

Declare the following over our building project:

“I call those things that are not as though they were. I call forth fullness of provision for every aspect of this building project. I declare God’s highest and best is done in this matter and the angels are now working on our behalf.”

Friday May 18 Proclamations for Blessing and Revival for the Body of Christ

- 1) *“Your Kingdom come! Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven!”* (Matthew 6:10)
- 2) *“For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.”* (Habukkuk 2:14)
- 3) *“Repent therefore and return, that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord.”* (Acts 3:19)
- 4) *“Blessed are your eyes, for they see; and your ears, for they hear.”* (Matthew 13:16)
- 5) *But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.”* (2 Corinthians 3:18)
- 6) *“Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.* (Isaiah 60:1)
- 7) *“Clear the way for the Lord in the wilderness; make smooth in the desert a highway for our God. Let every valley be lifted up, and every mountain and hill be made low; and let the rough ground become a plain and the rugged terrain a broad valley. Then the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken.”* (Isaiah 40:3-5)
- 8) *“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before Him in love.”* (Ephesians 1:3-4)
- 9) *“Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you(we) may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.”* (2 Peter 1:2-4)
- 10) *“So let us know, let us press on to know the Lord. His going forth is as certain as the dawn; and He will come to us like the rain, like the spring rain watering the earth.”* (Hosea 6:3)

Saturday May 19, 2007 Proclamations

- 1) *“The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.”* (Psalm 23:1,4)

- 2) *“The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?” (Psalm 27:1)*
- 3) *“Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favor my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.” (Psalm 35:27)*
- 4) *“Delight thyself also in the Lord: and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart. The steps of a good man are ordered of the Lord: and He delighteth in his way.” (Psalm 37:4, 23)*
- 5) *“There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For He shall give His angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.” (Psalm 91:10-11)*
- 6) *“Bless the Lord, O’ my soul, and forget not all His benefits; Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.” (Psalm 103:2-5)*
- 7) *“The Lord will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O’ Lord, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands.” (Psalm 138:8)*
- 8) *“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. Honor the Lord with your possessions, And the firstfruits of all your increase; So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.” (Proverbs 3:5,6,9,10)*
- 9) *“My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.” (Proverbs 4:20-23)*
- 10) *“He who guards his mouth preserves his life, But he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction. ‘Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.’ (Proverbs 13:3, Proverbs 18:21)*
